For her passion for excellence and innovation and her commitment to philanthropy, Big Spring native **Marie Hall**, a member of the Midland College Foundation Board, has been named "**Outstanding Philanthropist**" by the Permian Basin Chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals. Hall received the award at the group's annual National Philanthropy Day luncheon on Nov. 13. Her philanthropy embraces education, sports, law, medicine, nursing, research, the arts, rural health care and scholarships.

Hall manages various personal investments and maintains a strong philanthropic presence throughout the state. For her contributions to Texas Tech University, Hall was awarded a **Doctor of Humane Letters in 2002**. As a Texas Tech benefactor, she established the **Marie Hall Chair in Rural Health Care**; funded the creation of the **F. Marie Hall Synergistic Center at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center**; and established the **H. Deane Pierce Endowed Professorship in the College of Architecture**.

At the **University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston (UTMB)**, she is **Member Emerita of the Advisory Council of the School of Allied Health Sciences**.

At UTMB she and her mother established the **Granville T. Hall Chair in General Surgery** and the **Florence Thelma and Florence Marie Hall Endowment for Programs of Excellence in Education in Medical Sciences**.

At UTMB she also established **The Florence Thelma Hall Distinguished Professorship of Nursing** and the

**Florence Marie Hall Visiting Lecturer in Allied Health Sciences**. She established the **F. Marie Hall Magnetic Resonance Laboratory**.

She also has endowed programs at Texas A&M University and the University of Texas at Austin.

In Big Spring, she is a former director of State National Bank, a past member of the vestry of St. Mary's Episcopal Church and the board of the Big Spring Chamber of Commerce, United Way and the Dora Robert Rehabilitation Center.

She is a **Rotarian** and the recipient of the **Big Spring Area Chamber of Commerce Woman of the Year Award** and **The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston Mustard Seed Special Award**. She has served on the MC Foundation Board for three years and has contributed to several projects at MC.

**A \$600,000 GRANT WILL BE USED TO EXPAND** Midland College's role in addressing community development needs by establishing a **Science Technology Initiative** and a **Business and Economic Development Center (BEDC) Services Initiative**.

The **Hispanic Serving Institutions Assisting Communities (HSIAC)** grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development was announced in October by Congressman Randy Neugebauer.

Midland College will use the money to establish a non-credit Building Science Technology program at the Cogdell Learning Center. This initiative will then build affordable housing and train community members for entry-level construction industry jobs.

The Midland College Business and Economic Development Center (BEDC) Services Initiative will implement a mini-MBA seminar series for small business owners and individualized services to Midland. The money will also be used to expand the Business and Economic Development Center services.
