Trobaugh gift supports growing baccalaureate program

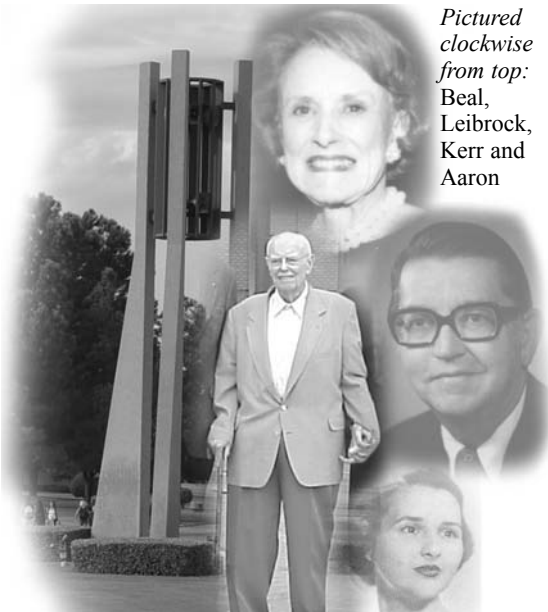
Midland College's Bachelor of Applied Technology (BAT) program — which just finished its second semester of classes — will expand and enroll more students after a visiting team from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) gave the program a positive assessment in April.

"This additional offering benefits our students, providing them a local opportunity to expand their Associate degree to the Bachelor's level," said MC President Dr. David Daniel.

A portion of the BAT funding was provided by the "Trobaugh Free Enterprise Chair," an endowed fund honoring the late Allen "Moose" Trobaugh, a former Midland College Foundation Board member.

Mr. Trobaugh was a member of the Midland College Foundation Board from 1977-1983. His wife, Melba, was a member from 1983 until 2004. The Trobaughs have been strong supporters of the college and its programs, including aviation maintenance technology, the Chaparral Circle Endowment Fund, the Fox Science Building, scholarships and athletics.

"This is an important event in the history of Midland College," Daniel said. "MC's review sends an important message: that business is now being done with new vision."

Todd Aaron

Todd Aaron, who, with his wife Dorothy, was a major contributor to the **Dorothy and Todd Aaron Medical Science Building**, died in February. The Aarons contributed \$1 million toward construction of the building that was named in their honor. Mrs. Aaron died in 1998.

The Aarons had a long-standing interest in both MC and the medical field. Mrs. Aaron attended MC from 1974 to 1976 before pursuing an advanced degree in creative writing. Mr. Aaron was the owner of Aaron Cable Tool Drilling Company. His father and grandfather were both medical doctors in the Indian Territory before Oklahoma became a state. Mr. Aaron's grandfather was a government physician who brought medical services to the Osage Indians.

Keleen Ashley Haubner Beal

Keleen Beal, who helped originate a major Midland family foundation, died on Wednesday, May 3, leaving behind a legacy of philanthropy that includes programs and buildings at Midland College. Mrs. Beal, with her husband, Carlton, created the Beal Foundation in 1959 — placing emphasis on educational, religious and charitable causes. She also served as chairman of the Foundation's board.

Mrs. Beal, along with members of the Beal family, were honored for their contributions to the college when Beal Plaza was dedicated on

September 21, 1978. Some of the many projects to which Keleen, Carlton Beal, Sr., and the Beal Foundation have donated include: the Advanced Technology Center; Dr. Gregory Bartha Health Sciences Scholarship; Beal Plaza (construction and landscaping); the Chaparral Circle Endowment Fund; the Fox Science Building; the General Academic Scholarship; and the Williams Regional Technical Training Center. The family suggested that memorials be made to the **Dr. Gregory Bartha Health Sciences Scholarship Fund** through the Midland College Foundation.

Ellana "Elle" Eastham Kerr

Longtime Midlander Elle Kerr died on March 28. She and her family had been longtime supporters of Midland College. That support began in 1975 when Mrs. Kerr's father, Harris G. Eastham, Jr., established the **Clara Eastham Endowed Scholarship** to honor his wife, Clara Eastham. Mrs. Kerr's family requested that memorials be directed to that scholarship, which provides tuition, fees and books for full- and part-time students.

Robert M. Leibrock

Robert M. Leibrock died on April 3 at age 85 in Midland after a long illness. He was a founding member of the Midland College Board of Trustees (1969), where he served 10 years. He was the second president of the board during the time the Al G. Langford Chaparral Center and other major buildings were constructed. Mr. Leibrock also served on the Midland College Foundation Board from 1974 to 1987. He was a trustee of the Abell-Hanger Foundation from 1979 to 1996. The family suggested that memorials be made to the Midland College Foundation.

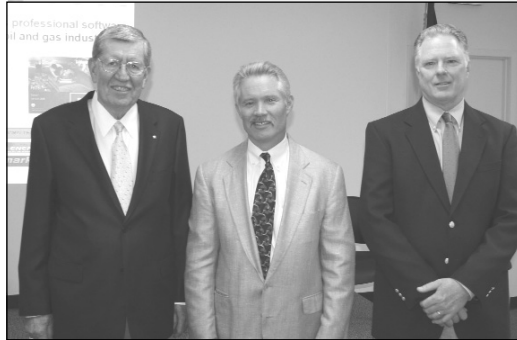

The **Petroleum Professional Development Center (PPDC)**, housed in the **Jack G. Elam Building**, re-opened with an **Open House** on May 3 after months of renovations and technology upgrades made possible by dozens of companies and individuals who contributed to the project.

Three classrooms, filled with computers running the latest industry software, were on the tour, along with a remodeled lecture hall fitted with state-of-the-art distance learning equipment.

The **PPDC** is a program resulting from the July 1, 2004 consolidation of the **Permian Basin Graduate Center** and MC's **Petroleum Geotechnology Training Center**. The consolidation created a dynamic and diverse continuing education program, which expands MC's ability to offer the latest industry education to area oil and gas personnel. It is one of only seven mid-career training centers worldwide recognized by the **American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG)**.

Design award affirms Chapel's unique mission

The design for Midland College's Dollye Neal Chapel has received an "Honor Award," the highest award given by the Lubbock Chapter of the American Institute of Architects. Parkhill, Smith and Cooper (PSC), architects for the Chapel, received the honor, which was awarded by a panel of three nationally distinguished architects who served as judges.

"This is unbelievable!!! I am astounded that a chapel on a college campus would receive this prestigious award. Most of all, I am so pleased for everyone who was involved in making the chapel possible.

This has become a place for reflection, thanksgiving, serenity, peace and joy for those who spend time in either the garden or the chapel," Chapel Donor Dollye Neal Ballenger said about the award.

The chapel received one of two awards given this year by the chapter, according to Dan Hart, the architect with PSC who worked on the chapel, implementing Mrs. Ballenger's vision. PSC has been responsible for the design of the college's seven newest buildings and is providing the design work for new construction taking place under last spring's bond issue.

Hart said the award means that Midland College and PSC have been affirmed in making excellent architecture. "The building is a threshold between Midland College and the community of Midland," Hart said, adding that it "reflects the faith of the donor and the vision of MC President Dr. David Daniel." Hart said it has always been the mission of Midland College and the vision of Dr. Daniel to be a part of the community — developing individuals and becoming one of the premier community colleges in the nation. "Midland College is a living, breathing example of fulfilled possibilities," Hart said.

The contest judge was David Daniel, the author of the poetry collection, *Seven-Star Bird*. He has been the poetry editor of *Ploughshares* for more than a decade, and he is director of the Creative Writing Program at Fairleigh Dickinson University.

John Updike has become one of the most successful American writers. As an essayist, Updike is a gentle satirist, poking fun at American life and customs, without mean-spirited nihilism. He observes the ordinary life he sees around him and frequently asks the reader to recognize and reconsider one's preconceptions. Updike is internationally known for his novels *Rabbit, Run, Rabbit Redux, Rabbit is Rich* and *Rabbit at Rest*. They follow the life of Harry “Rabbit” Angstrom, a star athlete, from his youth through the social and sexual upheavals of the 1960s, to later periods of his life, and to final decline. Updike has written much criticism — including reviewing the work of writers, including Philip Roth, Saul Bellow, Kurt Vonnegut, Joyce Carol Oates, Iris Murdoch, Umberto Eco, Gabriel García Márquez, Mario Vargas Llosa, and Isabel Allende.

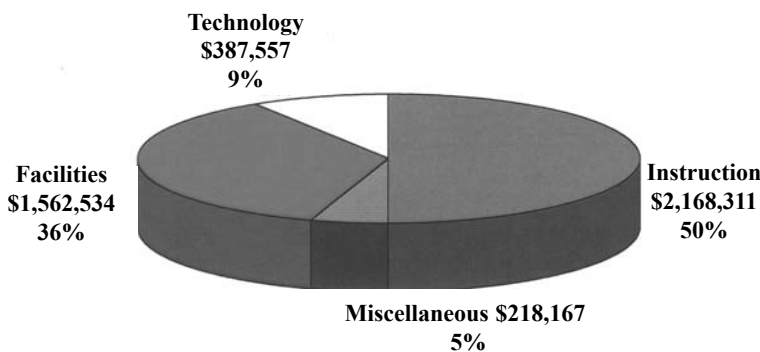

A College Classic



Dr. Stan Jacobs, Associate Vice President of Instruction - Transfer Studies, recently completed his 35th year at Midland College, the first and only MC employee to reach that milestone. To celebrate his achievement, Dr. Jacobs was honored with a lapis world globe, in recognition of his world travels as well as his years at MC, at the **MC Service Awards** on May 4. Dr. Jacobs arrived at MC in 1971 to teach art. He continues to teach art history along with his administrative duties. He also helped establish MC's popular **College Classics** program.

Since 1996, the Chaparral Circle Endowment Fund (CCEF), administered by the Midland College Foundation, has been able to use \$4.34 million in interest from the corpus to fund college projects — with \$190,000 awarded in April. The CCEF started with a campaign that received \$6.2 million in donations.



Bond Construction Update



Construction of the new campus **Warehouse**, the first major construction project being undertaken under last spring's \$41.8 million bond, is underway. The next project, expected to begin this month, will be the **Pedestrian Safety Measures**. This multi-part project — already reviewed by the MC board of trustees — will create pedestrian crosswalks, landscaped medians and sidewalks, designed to protect students and the Midlanders who choose the MC campus for walking, jogging, bicycling and walking their pets. MC officials hope for final administration and board approvals that will allow construction to begin late this summer on the new **Academic Building**, to be constructed just east of the Allison Fine Arts Building. The two-story building will provide additional classrooms, lecture halls, offices, an expanded University Center and a student lounge area.
