Marie Hall honored by Permian Basin Area Foundation

A reception was held by the Permian Basin Area Foundation (PBAF) on April 29 in honor of MC Foundation Board member Marie Hall for her "lifelong commitment to philanthropy." Miss Hall served as a member of the Board of Governors for PBAF, and established the **Marie Hall Scholarship Fund** in 1996 for students in the Permian Basin who were admitted to a college in West Texas.

Miss Hall's generosity has embraced education, health sciences, sports, law, medicine, nursing, research, the arts, rural health care and scholarships throughout the state. But, Midland College has benefited greatly, as well. Among her many gifts to MC, she funded **Hall's Way**, a pedestrian bridge linking MC to Midland Community Theatre, which the college dedicated in April, 2004.

DR. DAVID DANIEL

a tribute



Nationally known among community college leaders, MC President Dr. David Daniel will retire this year. "He is a very caring, meticulous and

thoughtful individual. Quality and service are paramount to him," said Executive Vice President Richard Jolly.

The list is endless: a 50 percent increase in enrollment; a \$41.8 million bond which passed with 70 percent approval; a baccalaureate degree; three new residence halls; the Advanced Technology Center; Cogdell Learning Center; a dining hall; a chapel; and a bridge. When asked about his successes at MC during his 17-year tenure, Dr. Daniel answers in his usual humble style. "The last thing you should do is give me credit," he said, "Our fantastic Board of Trustees has seen opportunities and allowed our administration to move forward."

MC is ranked tenth in the nation among community colleges for its foundation endowment. "This magic in our fundraising is due to the expertise of Dr. Eileen Piwetz," Dr. Daniel said. Vice President of Institutional Advancement Eileen Piwetz has worked very closely with Dr. Daniel in growing the MC Foundation to its total current assets of \$32 million! "What an honor it has been to work with a visionary such as David Daniel. He has been both a mentor and a friend, and I shall miss him greatly," said Dr. Piwetz.

Another longstanding servant of MC has been Richard Jolly. "Dr. Jolly is a brilliant educator who has instituted a curriculum appropriate for a community college. With everything, he puts our students first," said Dr. Daniel.

Without students and instructors there would be no MC. "Four-year universities are glad to have our graduates. This is a testament to the quality of our faculty," he said.

A huge surprise for Dr. Daniel was "the degree to which people have wrapped their arms around this institution. People often say to me, 'We're so proud of *our* college.' That sense of ownership means everything," Dr. Daniel said.

He sees a challenge in keeping up with technology, but believes "all signs show that we are a player in the advancing technological revolution." He is proud of MC's place among other community colleges, "the development of which has helped to keep this nation at the top of civilization as we know it," he said.

MC must face the challenges and opportunities of the future without David Daniel, as a new president will be hired before this fall semester. "I will never, *ever* lose my love for Midland College," Dr. Daniel said, "but will watch from a distance, and applaud the leadership that brings about change for the better."

Not too far a distance, we hope.

Medical Alliance stuff 5,000 envelopes, asking Midlanders to give a new kind of "valentine" to their doctors: in lieu of gifts, Ms. Hibbitts and Ms. Corwin ask that people make a gift to this MC scholarship fund in honor of their doctors. They stamp every envelope with a heart. Whether it is the heart on the envelope, or the generous hearts of these two women, our citizens have been compelled to give. In the Doctor's Day campaign for 2008, over \$17,175 has been raised! More may be coming in, too, because they keep their books open all year! And to date, since the Doctor's Day Observance began in 2001, over \$103,020 has been given to fund the **Midland Medical Alliance Doctor's Day Health Sciences Scholarship**.

"We wanted to do something that would have a long-term benefit, instead of something temporary," said Ms. Hibbitts. Some Doctor's Day recipients are transitioning from the L.V.N. into the R.N. program, which takes longer. But the scholarship is available to any MC student in Health Sciences. "One year a student's child had dental problems, and the bills wiped out her school money. But, she was able to continue because of the Doctor's Day scholarship ... this is why we reserved the scholarship for older students who might have extra responsibilities at home," continued Ms. Hibbitts.

Doctors enjoy Doctor's Day, too. "They love receiving the *Clarion* and seeing who gave a gift in their honor. Sometimes, it is the first personal 'thank you' they have had," said Ms. Corwin.

SIP was established in 1997 by the Abell-Hanger Foundation to provide student leaders the opportunity to improve the quality of life in their communities. In December of 2006, the Helen Greathouse Charitable Trust joined the Abell-Hanger Foundation in helping to fund the SIP Club. SIP members learn the importance of philanthropy and the role of board members who serve nonprofit organizations in the community. Since its inception, SIP members have reviewed a total of 298 grant applications, resulting in 165 grants funded, for a total of \$187,004 in monies raised and awarded to area nonprofits.

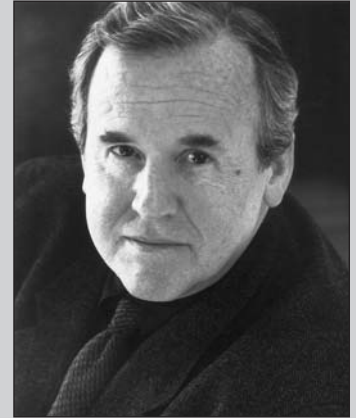

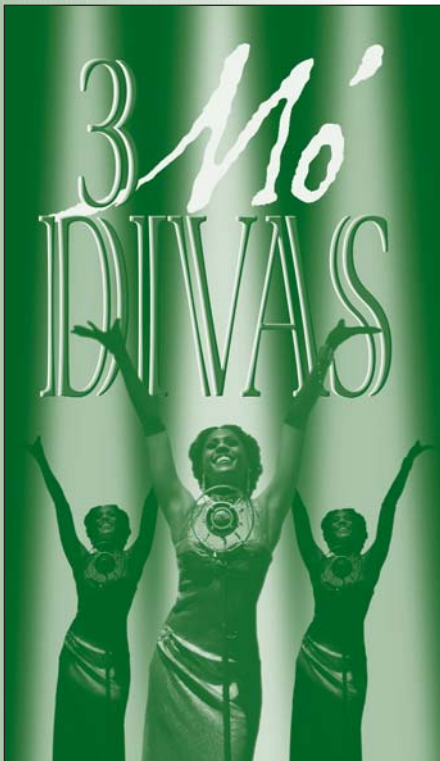

Former MC students establish scholarship

Former MC students Pauline and David Henry established the **Henry Scholarship** this past April to benefit an **Upward Bound** student who will be attending Midland College. Ms. Henry was part of the Upward Bound program, which she said helped her immensely. It is her goal through the Henry Scholarship to help the bright and motivated students in Upward Bound who cannot afford a college education.

Ms. Henry graduated from MC in 2002, finished her Bachelor of Science in Food and Nutrition at Texas Tech University and, in 2007, completed her M.B.A. at Tech.

Mr. Henry followed a similar path to success which began at MC, where his mother, Paula Henry, taught history. After completing his MC course work, David transferred to Texas Tech, and earned his Bachelor of Science in Personal Financial Planning.



John and Charlene Younger

The **John and Charlene Younger Scholarship** has been established to benefit two students who will transfer from Midland College to Texas A&M University. To qualify for the fund—which provides \$3,750 per semester to defray the costs of tuition, fees, books and miscellaneous fees—applicants must complete 25 hours of community service per semester, demonstrate financial need, maintain a 3.0 G.P.A., and commit to pursuing a degree in an academic field with the intent of transferring to Texas A&M University.

The scholarship has been funded in honor of the late John and Charlene Younger, who moved to West

Texas in 1954, where John was employed with the Western Company. He later became an independent oil operator and real estate developer. John was known by friends and family as “an avid Aggie,” but even more, a man with a “servant’s heart.” He gave quietly to individuals and organizations, performing countless “small miracles” for people from whom he never sought or received recognition. Though Mr. Younger passed away on October 1, 2005, his charitable heart will live on through the John and Charlene Younger Scholarship, which will continue to provide more miracles in the lives of our Midland College students.

Local chapter of national women’s organization gives to women of MC

The national Philanthropic Educational Organization (PEO) was founded in 1869 at Iowa Wesleyan College with a mission of “promoting educational opportunities for women.” The Midland chapter of PEO was founded in 1954, and is still going strong today with over 40 members. They have continued to honor their mission by establishing the **Philanthropic Educational Organization Memorial Scholarship** at MC, which is reserved for women “with a proven college record.”
